

### **Our Equine Friends: Memorial Scholarship**

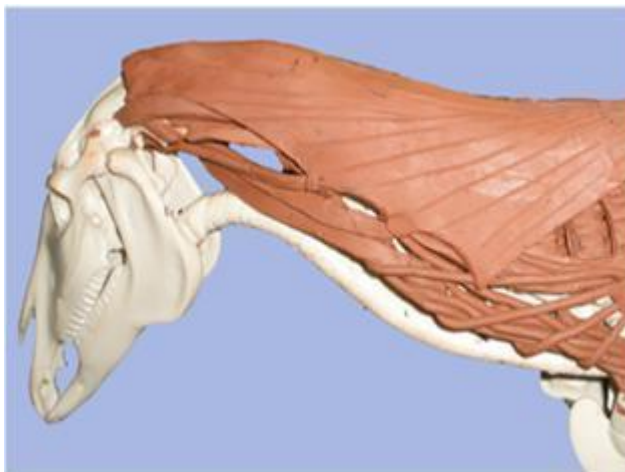
EQ900: Equine Anatomy Discovery Workshop (Clay and Hands On)

This Equine Friends Memorial Scholarship will cover the full tuition for one student for the EQ900: Equinology® Equine Anatomy Discovery Workshop (Clay and Hands On) held at the dates and locations above. This course is suitable for beginners to professionals. If this is your first anatomy or similar course please complete the EQ50: Equine Anatomy Distance Study prior to attending. While you do not need to know the muscles before attending this EQ900; having a good feel for the skeletal system and some vocabulary is recommended. Applicants must be able to attend the entire course so please check your schedule beforehand. Applicants must also be able to provide their own meals and accommodation. This scholarship is not transferable to any other course dates or locations other than those listed above.

You will need to be able to provide your own transportation to the locations. FYI, The Sea Ranch location is about 3 hours plus north of San Francisco. If you do travel via the bus, once you are here, transportation to and from your accommodation and the stable can easily be arranged. If possible we may be able to coordinate your transportation from SFO if flying in with another course participant but we cannot guarantee this. #### **Application Process:**

Applicants need to write an essay explaining why learning equine anatomy will help you reach your goals in the equine industry or enhance your knowledge as an owner. You should include your horse experience within the body of the essay. To attend this course, you must be experienced in working around all different types of dispositions and be comfortable in picking up all the limbs of the horse.

The scholarship will be awarded March 15, 2012 and announced on March 30th. **Please state which date(s) and location(s) you are interested in attending.** You can choose more than one. Please note that if a course does not run due to low enrollment there is no monetary compensation. You will be given the option to

attend one another EQ900 upcoming date. The winner will be notified via email on this date. If you have already registered for this course, you are welcome to apply for the scholarship. Any funds paid towards your tuition will be returned.
